## **DIABETES CAMPS**

The **Barton Center** hosts a variety of camps:

1. Mini-Camp in North Oxford, MA, ages 6-17 for girls only; one week or two-week programs offered.
2. Rainbow Club in Greenwich, CT, age's 3-10 co-ed; usually runs in June and parents can stay for all day educational sessions while the kids are in camp.
3. Mt. Sinai/Barton Day Camp in Central Park, ages 6-12 co-ed; usually runs in August.
4. Barton Day Camp, Long Island at Holy Child Academy in Westbury, NY, ages 6-12 co-ed; usually runs July.
