EVENT DETAILS

The walk will be hosted at the North Park Swimming Pool on Saturday, October 28th^t. The walk site opens at **10:00am**, the ceremony and T1D Parade begin at **11:30am**, and the walk is immediately following. Please plan to arrive by 10:00am to allow time to turn in donations at the registration tent, enjoy activities, meet families, take photos, and more! If you need assistance on walk day, volunteers will be in light blue t-shirts and JDRF staff will be in orange t-shirts.

PARKING

There is limited, free parking available at the North Park Swimming Pool. A parking pass is required to enter the lot. Cars without a parking pass will have to park at overflow parking and take the shuttle. Parking pass may be printed or shown on your phone. To prevent traffic, please have parking pass ready. V1Ps will have reserved spaces at the North Park Swimming Pool lot. Once the lot is full, cars will park at Beattie Tech and take the shuttle (9600 Babcock Blvd, Allison Park, PA 15101).

You'll hear more instructions during the opening ceremony.
